

PROTAGONISM PROGRAM OF CHILDHOOD AND ADOLESCENCE

School for Families



The lesson plan at the school in the primary and secondary level is presented as a project. It is in doing, in learning from an experience that the students can analyze and come to understand the subject matter being presented. Designing and participating in activities will give greater depth to what the students are experimenting.

A meeting is planned at the start and end of each project where the parents are informed and are promoted to participate in the subject matter being presented to their children. The students respond better when they have the support of their parents.

The subject matter of this past quarter “Comprehensive Sexuality Education” was addressed. The families of the students were organized according to the level in which their children are in relation to the need for depth of the subject matter.

In the first stage, the subject matter of body recognition, care and hygiene, sexuality and prevention of violence was addressed.

In the second stage, sex, sexuality, gender, changes in their body according to age, and prevention of violence were discussed.

In each stage, the parents in attendance participated in different activities to learn about the subject matter being given to their children. It is important that the parents understand the importance of accompanying their children in their sexual development. Many parents fail to do this. Their parents never talked to them about their sexuality.



The parents who participated in the activity showed their interest and gratitude to the school for addressing these issues with their children. What was discussed, gave them clear information to address the issue and use the right words to convey this information to their children.

At the end of the meeting, reading material developed for parents was shared with 5 topics on Comprehensive Sexuality Education.
